

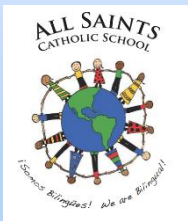
# All Saints Catholic School



All Saints Catholic began its transition to becoming a two-way immersion program with PK3 & PK4 in the 2015-2016 school year. The school will continue to add one grade level each year until the school is transitioned through the 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Two-way immersion is a form of dual language that combines two language groups while providing instruction in both languages. In addition, the classes will be comprised of approximately one-half fluent English speakers and the other half fluent Spanish speakers. Students will learn the academic curriculum through both languages simultaneously. In this way, students serve as language models for each other, which accelerates their learning. The primary goal of All Saint's dual language program is to allow all students to realize the full benefits of bilingualism which include enhanced cognitive ability, increased academic achievement, heightened multicultural appreciation and understanding, and a competitive edge in the increasingly global society of the 21st century.
